**GREEN ROOM FEST, CHIMNEY FARM (26th-29th June, 2017)**

We're coming to the end of another fantastic year at The Green Room and so, following on from the success of our first ever residential trip last year, we would like to take all pupils and staff on another trip away. This year, we will be hosting the first ever **Green Room Festival** and putting the lovely Chimney Farm to use. All of our pupils who have visited the farm agree that it's a magical place, so where better to hold our very own festival?

The trip will start from The Green Room on **Monday 26th June** when pupils travel to school via their normal transport with their belongings. We will then travel to the farm in our two school buses, with the aim of arriving at the farm at 11.30am.

The trip will finish on Thursday 29th June and we aim to be returning to The Green Room for 12pm. Travel arrangements for each pupil will be organised to ensure they get home safely. There will be no school on Friday 30th June.

We are lucky enough to have secured luxury bell tents for our camping trip (in which there will be a separate boys and girls campsite), meaning pupils should be very comfortable for their entire stay. Staff will be on call throughout the night as needed. During the day, we will be running a wide range of activities for our pupils to choose from. These vary from calming meditation and yoga to paddle boarding around our very own lake!

We want this trip to be a memorable experience for all involved and we will cover the majority of the cost. However, please could we ask for a £50 deposit to confirm your child's place by Monday 19th June (cash or cheque made payable to *Everyday Arts.
