On Friday 15th March, The Green Room School will be taking all of our pupils on a school trip to The Planetarium at the Royal Observatory in Greenwich. This trip will be on the final day of British Science Week and should be a brilliant conclusion to a fantastic week.

British Science Week provides a great opportunity to shine the spotlight on a subject area that sometimes gets lost amongst the other dates in the Cultural Calendar, and this year's theme of 'Time' is one that will provide the school with an impetus across the week.

From Monday to Thursday we will be running a regular timetable, but British Science Week will sit above the curriculum and will be highlighted through the running of mini-experiments, interactive resources and insightful discussion.

On Friday we will take our school minibus to Slough station and travel the rest of the way by train, arriving at the Observatory in time to watch 'Final Frontier'....
