Criteria Used to Award and Allocate Word Processors for Examinations

The Green Room awards and allocates word processors to candidates of public examinations who use a word processor as their normal way of working in class and for whom we are able to establish appropriate evidence of need in line with JCQ and other exam body rules.

Typically word processors may be awarded to candidates with:

A learning disability which has a substantial and long term adverse effect on their ability to write legibly.

A medical condition.

A physical disability.


A sensory impairment.
