THE GREEN ROOM KINGSLEY:

We are an independent school sert on a farm which gives us the freedom to give our 30 pupils a second chance at education. Our dedicated team provides a broad, lively, and stimulating curriculum for our pupils, ranging from English, Maths, Science and other academic subjects to vocational studies, including BTEC Land Based Studies, Construction and Bushcraft. We focus on inspiring change within our pupils to ensure their successful future- our pupils want to be at GRK, it is not a place they are 'sent'.

PURPOSE OF THE LSA ROLE:

To provide support to the teacher whilst they perform their daily tasks in the learning environment with an assigned group of young people. Be responsible for making the learning environment ready for teaching prior to the beginning of each session and helping the teacher whilst the session is in progress. To deliver lessons either on a 1:1 or small group basis by teaching/supporting our pupils working at all levels from KS1-4 enabling them to achieve rapid progress. Outside session times perform administrative tasks and make sure that the teacher is satisfied with the learning environment. Take part in all kinds of sessions and activities throughout a typical working day. Ensure the safety and welfare of the students during on-site and off-site activities. Promote the aims of our organisation, and reinforce our ethos. Most importantly inspire our students to be kind, brave and honest and true to themselves.

MAIN DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Act as a mentor to pupils providing them with time to talk and in response give guidance and kindness
- Preparing the physical learning environment for sessions/workshops/activities
- Ensuring that learning materials are ready for use
- Helping teacher to plan sessions
- Helping students who have learning difficulties to complete tasks
- Taking charge of group activities and making sure all students are involved
- Providing general encouragement for all the students in the class
- Taking extra time to explain the learning material to students who have not understood it the first time

- Helping tutors to assess the work and providing feedback to the students
- Keeping parents informed of the progress of the young person and listening to any queries
- To reinforce boundaries at all times, and ensuring safety and well being
- To plan opportunities to develop social, emotional and sporting needs of each student
- To participate in staff briefings and team meetings where appropriate
