GR-Expedition 2021 - Swanage Jurassic Coast

After the success of the last expedition to Swanage Jurassic Coast back in 2019, The Green Room School are running a lower school expedition to the Jurassic Coast in Swanage this year.

The trip will commence on Wednesday 31st June and will run for two nights. Pupils and staff will be travelling to Swanage via minibus and will set up camp at Woodyhyde Campsite, where we have been granted access to the Duke of Edinburgh campsite. Pupils will arrive at school at their normal time via their usual transport.

Medication

If your child requires medication during the trip please complete the consent form and ensure the medication is brought to school in its original packaging with complete dosage instructions. We will not have refrigeration facilities for medicines. We will have pain relief and hayfever tablets and already have your instructions whether or not your child can take paracetamol, ibuprofen and antihistamine. First Aid, if required, will be delivered during the trip.

Food Allergies and Dietary Requirements

Food and snacks will be provided. There is no reason to bring additional food or drinks and we actively encourage pupils not to. We already have a record of your child's allergies and dietary requirements but do get in touch if you have any concerns.

Electrical equipment and Valuables



Please note there will be no Wi-Fi during the trip. If electronic devices are brought along they are solely the pupils' responsibility and we recommend keeping valuables and precious items safely at home.

Money

Pupils need to bring some money to cover their meals during the travel element of the trip: they'll need money for lunch on the first day or a packed lunch, and money for a meal in the afternoon on the way back on the third day.
