GUIDANCE FOR VISITING GREEN ROOM SITES

This guidance is intended for **all** visitors to Green Room sites including The Swan in Windsor and Allotments; and is based on the latest Government Guidance. This will be revised as government guidance is amended. All our sites undergo deep cleaning prior to pupil return.

Process

- 1. Everyone is advised not to come to a Green Room site if they have a **dry cough or temperature above 37.5 degrees celsius**. If someone exhibits a dry cough or temperature whilst at Green Room sites they will be sent home.
- 2. Everyone opening the outside door will use hand **sanitiser or other virus cleansing product on the door handle** and push plate immediately after opening.
- 3. On entry, everyone will **wash their hands** for at least 20 seconds in the manner prescribed by Public Health England hand washing posters are next to all hand washing facilities at Green Room sites.
- 4. Everyone will take their own **temperature** with a thermometer that does not touch the person. This will then be wiped with hand sanitiser to clean it after use. If the temperature is over 37.5 degrees the person will be sent home.
- 5. **Hand sanitiser or handwashing** (whichever is appropriate to the activity in hand) to be done regularly throughout the day, and before eating or handling food. Note the government guidance: *It is essential that everyone washes their hands more often, using soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Hand washing with soap employs mechanical action that loosens bacteria and viruses from the skin, rinsing them into the drain. Drying hands afterwards makes the skin less hospitable to the virus. Hand sanitiser can be effective if soap is not available or the situation makes using soap less feasible (i.e. when outside) but using hand sanitiser provides none of the virus-destroying friction that rubbing your hands together and rinsing with water provides.*
- 6. Everyone will practise **social distancing** by keeping 2 metres apart from other people.
- 7. Any exterior handles or gates or items that will be used by another person (eg garden tools) that are touched are to be cleaned with hand sanitiser or other virus cleansing product afterwards.

Note the front gate of GRK to be left open. Specifically, only GRK materials, tools and equipment to be used, and NO Blaber Enterprise equipment to be used and no one is to access the animal field and the track between it and the Blaber home. The route to the allotment is through the new barn, down the steps, down the track between the animal field and the horses and then left to the allotment field. Specifically do not go near building contractors personnel and equipment onsite at GRK or other allotment users.
