Dear Parents and Carers,

As you will know, (much to the relief of many parents!) schools will be re-opening next week for all pupils. This is excellent news for all those young people across the country who have been locked down for such a long time.

The current situation at The Green Room is that we have two thirds of our pupils in physical school at any one time, with the rest in online school. Pupils are in 3 days in school, 2 days at home. All staff have also been tested twice a week, with pupils starting twice-weekly testing next week. This is working well. We have had no positive cases and have been able to keep our bubble clean and safe.

Re-opening the schools is a big step and not without its concerns. As I said in my previous letter before half term, in order to maintain a consistent and safe working environment, I foresaw our current timetable running up until the Easter holidays, four weeks from now. This is beneficial to many of our pupils and families who are anxious about a full school return and where big changes part way through a term are unsettling.

However, if the full school return next week will allow you to return to work, or you have other concerns about your child being at home, and think they would benefit from more time in school this term, please do let me know and we can work on a phased return to full time school,

We are still unable to use the Windsor Leisure Centre for sport, but as soon as this re-opens, we will re-start our sports programme. Ideally this will be from April 12th (we cannot wait to get back in the gym and onto the bench ball pitch). We are also making plans for GR Fest, our summer camping trip and lots more for the summer term, which I am expecting to be back to normal. Watch this space for more information.
