Dear parents and carers,

Next week we will be embarking on our curriculum collapse week. This is a great opportunity for our young people to engage in a cross curricular experience aimed at provoking curiosity and consolidating the interconnected nature of our taught subjects.

For the last three days before the October half term we'll be investigating Biomes. A Biome is a "a large geographic area defined by its specific climate, which includes factors like temperature and rainfall, and is characterised by the types of plants and animals that live there. These areas are essentially large-scale ecosystems." So, biomes we might experience could be: rainforests, deserts, grasslands, tundras or cities.

Students have been sent a google form so that they can select the sessions they would like to attend. Individual time tables will be provided to students but attached to this letter is the full time table so that you can see what is happening across the school.

On Tuesday we will be visiting Kew Gardens for the day. Students can arrive at normal times but I would stress that I would like to leave school at 10 am to maximise our time. We will be travelling from Windsor and Eton Riverside via train to Richmond before getting an overground train to Kew. From there it is a short walk. We will be back at the knoll for usual pick up times and taxi's etc.
