## Slovenia trip - March 2026

Dear Parents and Carers,

Here at The Green Room School we pride ourselves on being audacious. We believe in the value of education in and beyond the classroom. Trips are seen as a vital part of a young person's education and we strive to provide as many enrichment opportunities as possible. Offering an excellent combination of natural beauty, including alpine scenery and lakes, as well as a cultural experience in Ljubljana. Slovenia has fairy tale scenery as well as a fascinating history as it fought for its independence and redefined itself from former Yugoslavia. Slovenia has a rich mediaeval history and some outstanding examples of Baroque architecture.

The four-day trip will be focused on visiting world renown sites as well as places of significance from Medieval Europe (please see suggested itinerary overleaf).
