Runnymede Trip Monday 15th September 2025

Dear Parents and Carers,

I'm writing to inform you that on Monday 15th September our Year 12 students will be taken on a local visit as part of their Phenomenon Based learning lesson.

We will be visiting Runnymede, which is a 9-minute drive from The Swan, in the school minibus. The visit will run from 10am-12pm and students will be driven back to The Swan in time for lunch. There is no change to student transport or lunch arrangements.

Students are advised to bring a waterproof layer in case of wet weather, but umbrellas will also be on hand if needed. At Runnymede we will be walking a short distance, mostly on paths but comfortable outdoor shoes such as trainers are recommended.

Our visit to the historic sites of Runnymede will kick start our exploration of the topic of constitutions. Students will learn about Magna Carta, which was signed at Runnymede and began a movement away from feudalism to a system-based on liberties, rights and freedoms. Beside the memorial to Magna Carta, there is, on a patch of American soil on which John F. Kennedy's memorial is located, and a thought provoking art installation called Writ in Water.
